# Mark Hylkema, Ph.D.

Topic: The Castroville Mammoth Project and Search for the First People of the Americas

Recently, the excavation of a Colombian Mammoth in the artichoke fields of Castroville has allowed us to see into the world that existed in the Monterey Bay region at the end of the Great Ice Age (Pleistocene). The disappearances of many different species of Rancho La Brean Mega-fauna, including mammoths, giant sloths, horses, camels, mastodons, saber-tooth cats, and other creatures, is coincident with the first archaeological evidence of human arrivals into the Americas. Did the early Paleo-Indians extirpate these species, or did abrupt climate changes account



He works full time as the Santa Cruz District Archaeologist for California State Parks managing cultural resources in an area stretching from San Francisco to the Pajaro River; and has taught undergraduate and graduate classes at Santa Clara University, University of California at Santa Cruz, De Anza College, Ohlone College, Cabrillo College, and Foothill College. A native of Mountain View and Los Altos, he currently resides in Sunnyvale.
