Discussion of three possible locations for our General Meeting for the coming year was based on personal meetings with staff and Fred's excellent chart comparing Stevenson, Porter Hall and Colleges 9/10 Multipurpose Room. Info was gathered by Mark, Dennis, Corinne, Sally and Fred. Consensus is that Colleges 9/10 offered the most comfortable, welcoming space and staff support and had the most compatible mission. Dennis moved we accept Colleges 9/10's offer to host us. Seconded and Passed.
