The ASB includes a free Flea Market for Farmworker Families in Watsonville.

- Children's clothing
- Children's books in English
- Small appliances in working order (e.g. microwaves, hot plates, lamps)
- Personal items: Shampoo, hand soap, dish soap, laundry soap, TP, and paper towels.
